Our Services

Social Programs & Events

We offer weekday, evening and weekend programs that help participants build friendships, explore interests, enjoy new experiences and stay connected to their community. Activities take place at our hubs and out in the community, based on each person's goals, interests and support needs.

Life Skills & Capacity Building

We support participants to build practical everyday skills and greater independence. This may include communication, decision-making, personal organisation, travel training, cooking and community participation, with personalised support at our hubs and in the community.

Short-Term Respite

Our short-term respite options give participants a change of scenery, new experiences and continued support in a safe environment, while giving families and carers time to rest and recharge. Options are flexible and tailored to individual needs and preferences.

In-Home & Individualised Support

Our individualised support provides one-to-one assistance for participants who prefer personalised support. This may include community access, appointments, daily living skills, hobbies and building confidence in social settings, with supports tailored to each person's goals.

School Leaver Employment Supports (SLES)

Our SLES program helps young people build confidence, practical life skills and workplace readiness as they transition from school to further education, training or employment.

Supported Independent Living (SIL)

We assist participants to live as independently as possible in shared or individual living arrangements. Our team provides daily living support, personal care and skill development in a safe and supportive home environment. We operate a SIL house in West Hoxton.

Transport Assistance

We provide accessible transport support to help participants travel safely to programs, appointments and community activities, promoting independence and participation.
